Mediates the selective degradation of short-lived and abnormal proteins. Functions in the E6/E6-AP-induced ubiquitination of p53/TP53.,pathway:Protein modification; protein ubiquitination.,similarity:Belongs to the ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme family.,subunit:Bounds UBE3A, HEI10, CBL, ZAP70, RNF19A, RNF19B and RNF144B.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous, with highest expression in testis.,
Background	The modification of proteins with ubiquitin is an important cellular mechanism for targeting abnormal or short-lived proteins for degradation. Ubiquitination involves at least three classes of enzymes: ubiquitin-activating enzymes (E1s), ubiquitin-conjugating enzymes (E2s) and ubiquitin-protein ligases (E3s). This



gene encodes a member of the E2 ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme family. This enzyme is demonstrated to participate in the ubiquitination of p53, c-Fos, and the NF- κ B precursor p105 in vitro. Several alternatively spliced transcript variants have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2009],

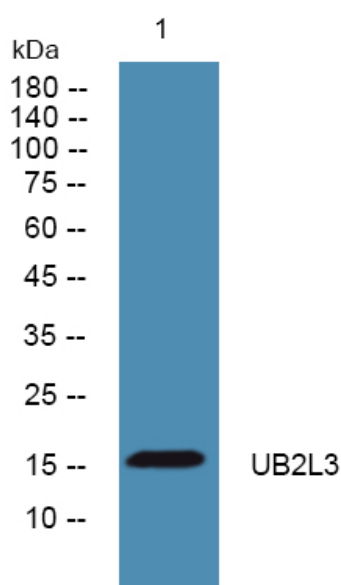
