Function	function:Component of the transcription factor SL1/TIFIB complex involved in the assembly of the PIC (preinitiation complex).,similarity:Belongs to the TAF1 family.,subunit:Component of the transcription factor SL1/TIFIB complex which is composed of TBP and at least TAF1A, TAF1B and TAF1C. In the complex, interacts directly with TBP, TAF1A and TAF1C. Interaction of the SL1/TIFIB subunits with TBP excludes interaction with the transcription factor IID (TFIID) subunits. This mutually exclusive binding directs the formation of promoter and RNA polymerase-selective TBP-TAF complexes.,	
Background	Initiation of transcription by RNA polymerase I requires the formation of a complex composed of the TATA-binding protein (TBP) and three TBP-associated factors (TAFs) specific for RNA polymerase I. This complex, known as SL1, binds to the core promoter of ribosomal RNA genes to position the polymerase properly and acts as a channel for regulatory signals. This gene encodes one of the SL1-specific TAFs. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have
