Function	domain:PDZ 6 mediates interaction with the PDZ recognition motif of EFNB1 and EPHB2 and with the C-terminus of PPFIA1 and PPFIA4. PDZ 4 and PDZ 5 mediate interaction with the C-terminus of GRIA2 and GRIA3. PDZ 4, PDZ 5 and PDZ 6 mediate homomultimers. PDZ 7 mediates interaction with PDZ domain of GRASP1. PDZ 7 domain binds CSPG4. PDZ 6 mediates interaction with the C-terminus of liprins-alpha. PDZ 1, PDZ 2 and PDZ 3 mediate interaction with the PDZ-binding motif of FRAS1 (By similarity). PDZ 4 and PDZ 5 mediate interaction with PRLHR.,function:May play a role as a localized scaffold for the assembly of a multiprotein signaling complex and as mediator of the trafficking of its binding partners at specific subcellular location in neurons.,similarity:Contains 7 PDZ (DHR) domains.,subcellular location:Cytoplasmic and membrane-associated with

vesicles, peri-Golgi complexes and endoplasmic ret

glutamate receptor interacting protein 1 (GRIP1) Homo sapiens This gene encodes a member of the glutamate receptor interacting protein family. The encoded scaffold protein binds to and mediates the trafficking and membrane organization of a number of transmembrane proteins.
