Cell Pathway	Golgi apparatus. Cytoplasmic vesicle, clathrin-coated vesicle membrane; Peripheral membrane protein; Cytoplasmic side. Component of the coat surrounding the cytoplasmic face of coated vesicles located at the Golgi complex.

Function	function:Subunit of clathrin-associated adaptor protein complex 1 that plays a role in protein sorting in the trans-Golgi network (TGN) and endosomes. The AP complexes mediate the recruitment of clathrin to membranes and the recognition of sorting signals within the cytosolic tails of transmembrane cargo molecules.,PTM:Phosphorylation of membrane-bound AP1M1/AP1M2 increases its affinity for sorting signals.,similarity:Belongs to the adaptor complexes medium subunit family.,similarity:Contains 1 MHD (mu homology) domain.,subcellular location:Component of the coat surrounding the cytoplasmic face of coated vesicles located at the Golgi complex.,subunit:Adaptor protein complex 1 (AP-1) is an heterotetramer composed of two large adaptins (gamma-type subunit AP1G1 and beta-type subunit AP1B1), a medium adaptin (mu-type subunit AP1M1 or AP1M2) and a small adaptin (sigma-type subunit AP1S1 or A


