Tissue Specificity	Brain,
Function	function:Recruits the serine/threonine-protein phosphatase PP1 to dephosphorylate the translation initiation factor eIF-2A/EIF2S1, thereby reversing the shut-off of protein synthesis initiated by stress-inducible kinases and facilitating recovery of cells from stress. Down-regulates the TGF-beta signaling pathway by promoting dephosphorylation of TGFB1 by PP1. May promote apoptosis by inducing TP53 phosphorylation on 'Ser-15'.induction:By methyl methanesulfonate and ionizing irradiation. By IL24 in melanoma cells; which induces apoptosis.,miscellaneous:The phosphatase activity of the PPP1R15A-PP1 complex toward EIF2S1 is specifically inhibited by Salubrinal, a drug that protects cells from endoplasmic reticulum stress.,PTM:Phosphorylated



on tyrosine by LYN; which impairs its antiproliferative activity.,similarity:Belongs to the PPP1R15 family.,subunit:Interacts with PCNA (By similarity)

Background

This gene is a member of a group of genes whose transcript levels are increased following stressful growth arrest conditions and treatment with DNA-damaging agents. The induction of this gene by ionizing radiation occurs in certain cell lines regardless of p53 status, and its protein response is correlated with apoptosis following ionizing radiation. 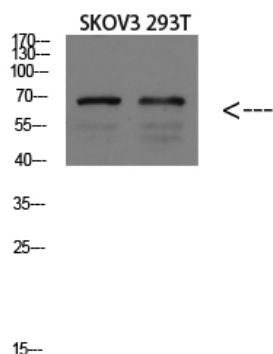
