Function	catalytic activity:ATP + a protein = ADP + a phosphoprotein.,function:Probable actin-based motor with a protein kinase activity.,similarity:Contains 1 myosin head-like domain.,similarity:Contains 1 protein kinase domain.,similarity:Contains 2 IQ domains.,similarity:In the N-terminal section; belongs to the protein kinase superfamily. STE Ser/Thr protein kinase family.,tissue specificity:Expressed in retina, kidney and testis.,
Background	This gene encodes one of the class III myosins. Myosins are ATPases, activated by actin, that move along actin filaments in the cell. This class of myosins are characterized by an amino-terminal kinase domain and shown to be present in photoreceptors. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms. [provided by RefSeq, Mar 2014],
