Function	function:Transcriptional activator. Binds the consensus sequence 5'-DHWATTGAYTWWD-3' on a variety of gene promoters such as those of HNF3B and TTR. Important for liver genes transcription.,online information:Hepatocyte nuclear factors entry,similarity:Belongs to the CUT homeobox family.,similarity:Contains 1 CUT DNA-binding domain.,similarity:Contains 1 homeobox DNA-binding domain.,subunit:Binds DNA as a monomer.,tissue specificity:Highly expressed in liver; lower expression in testis and skin.,
Background	This gene encodes a member of the Cut homeobox family of transcription factors. Expression of the encoded protein is enriched in the liver, where it stimulates transcription of liver-expressed genes, and antagonizes glucocorticoid-stimulated gene transcription. This gene may influence a variety of cellular processes including glucose metabolism, cell cycle regulation, and it may also be associated with cancer.
