Function	function:May play a role in vesicle-mediated protein trafficking to lysosomal compartments and in membrane docking/fusion reactions of late endosomes/lysosomes.,similarity:Belongs to the VPS11 family.,similarity:Contains 1 clathrin repeat.,similarity:Contains 1 RING-type zinc finger.,subcellular location:Cytoplasmic, peripheral membrane protein associated with late endosomes/lysosomes.,subunit:Large hetero-oligomeric complex together with VPS16, VPS18 and VPS33A. Interacts with STX7.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous. Expression was highest in heart and low in lung.,
Background	Vesicle mediated protein sorting plays an important role in segregation of intracellular molecules into distinct organelles. Genetic studies in yeast have identified more than 40 vacuolar protein sorting (VPS) genes involved in vesicle transport to vacuoles. This gene encodes the human homolog of yeast class C Vps11 protein. The mammalian class C Vps proteins are predominantly



associated with late endosomes/lysosomes, and like their yeast counterparts, may mediate vesicle trafficking steps in the endosome/lysosome pathway. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Feb 2014],
