<b>Purification</b>	The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

<b>Tissue Specificity</b>	Colon cancer,Small intestine,Synovium,Testis,
<b>Function</b>	function:May be involved in the reorganization of actin cytoskeleton mediated by RND1, RND2 AND RND3. Promotes RHOA activation mediated by GNA12 and GNA13.,polymorphism:The number of repeats is polymorphic and varies from 1 to 4.,similarity:Contains 1 SEP domain.,similarity:Contains 1 UBX domain.,subunit:Interacts with GNA12, GNA13, RND1, RND2 AND RND3.,
<b>Background</b>	This gene encodes a protein with a divergent C-terminal UBX domain. The homologous protein in the rat interacts with members of the Rnd subfamily of Rho GTPases at the cell periphery through its C-terminal region. It also interacts with several heterotrimeric G proteins through their G-alpha subunits and promotes Rho GTPase activation. It is proposed to serve a bidirectional role in the promotion and inhibition of Rho activity through upstream signaling pathways. The 3' coding sequence of this gene contains a polymorphic region of 24 nt



tandem repeats. Several transcripts containing between 1.5 and five repeat units have been reported. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],

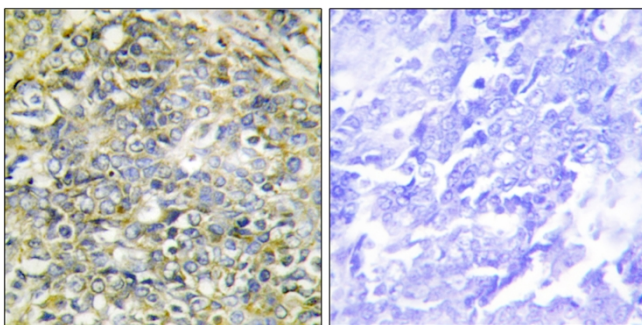

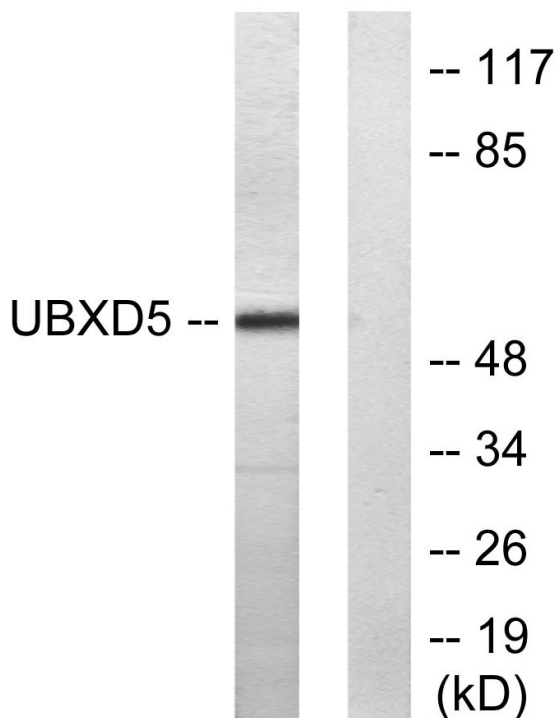
