Cell Pathway	Cell membrane; Single-pass type II membrane protein. Cell membrane; Lipid-anchor. Secreted. Also exists as a soluble excreted form, sCD23.
Tissue Specificity	B-cell,Blood,
Function	function:This receptor has essential roles in the regulation of IgE production and in the differentiation of B-cells (it is a B-cell-specific antigen).,miscellaneous:There are two kinds of Fc receptors for IgE, which differ in both structure and function: high affinity receptors on basophils and mast cells and low affinity receptors on lymphocytes and monocytes.,online information:CD23,PTM:N- and O-glycosylated.,similarity:Contains 1 C-type lectin domain.,subcellular location:Also exists as a soluble excreted form.,
Background	The protein encoded by this gene is a B-cell specific antigen, and a low-affinity receptor for IgE. It has essential roles in B cell growth and differentiation, and the regulation of IgE production. This protein also exists as a soluble secreted form, then functioning as a potent mitogenic growth factor. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been described for this gene.[provided by RefSeq, Jul 2011],

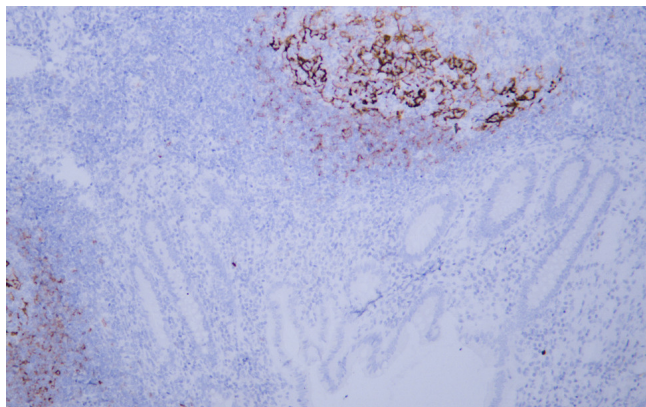

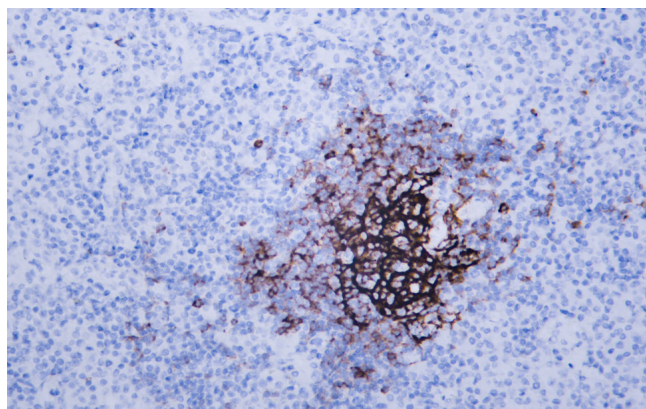

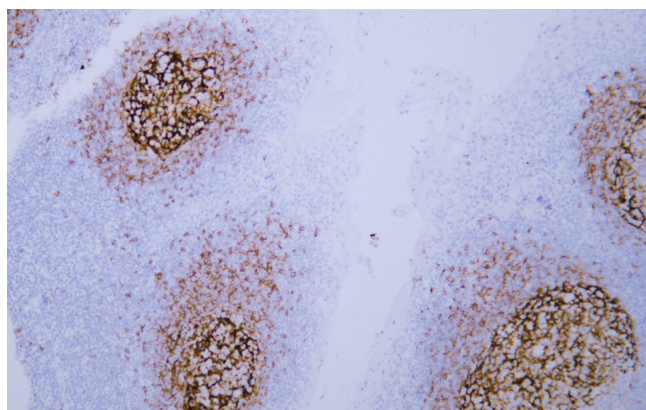
