Cell Pathway	Nucleus matrix. Localized to the nuclear matrix-intermediate filament scaffold. Isoform 2 is also found in some cytoplasmic extensions.
Tissue Specificity	Abundantly expressed in brain. Also found in several tumors such as lung carcinomas, nervous tumors and HL-60 leukemia cells. Isoform 3 is the major form in U-937, GOTO and HL-60 leukemia cells.
Function	induction: Down-regulated in HL-60 leukemia cells by RA, PMA and dimethyl sulfoxide.; similarity: Belongs to the phosphatase and actin regulator family.; similarity: Contains 4 RPEL repeats.; subcellular location: Localized to the nuclear matrix-intermediate filament scaffold. Isoform 2 is also found in some cytoplasmic extensions.; subunit: Binds actin and PPP1CA; thus inhibiting the protein phosphatase 1 (PP1) activity.; tissue specificity: Abundantly expressed in brain. Also found in several tumors such as lung carcinomas, nervous tumors and HL-60 leukemia cells. Isoform 3 is the major form in U937, GOTO and HL-60 leukemia cells.;
Background	This gene encodes a member of the phosphatase and actin regulator protein family. The encoded protein is associated with the nuclear scaffold in proliferating cells, and binds to actin and the catalytic subunit of protein phosphatase-1, suggesting that it functions as a regulatory subunit of protein phosphatase-1. 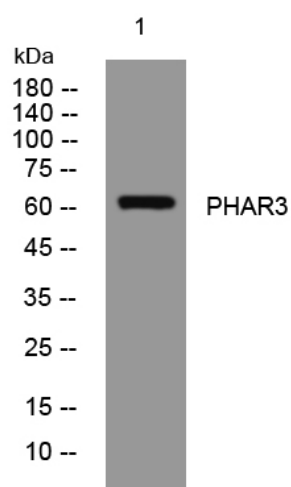

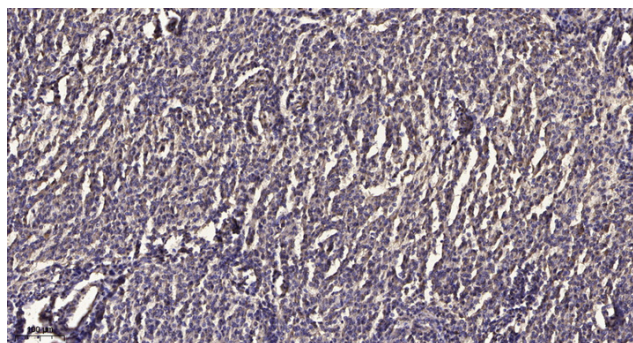
