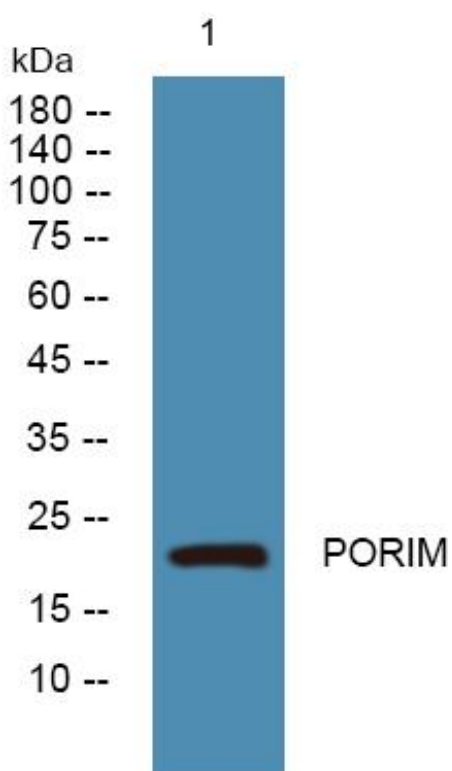

Cell Pathway	Membrane ; Single-pass type I membrane protein .
Tissue Specificity	Ubiquitous. Not expressed in ovary. Expressed in keratinocytes.
Function	function:Implicated in oncotic cell death, characterized by cell swelling, organelle swelling, vacuolization and increased membrane permeability.,similarity:Belongs to the CD164 family.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous. Not expressed in ovary. Expressed in keratinocytes.,
Background	This gene encodes a highly glycosylated transmembrane protein with a high content of threonine and serine residues in its extracellular domain, similar to a broadly defined category of proteins termed mucins. Exposure of some cell types to anti-PORIMIN (pro-oncosis receptor inducing membrane injury) antibody, crosslinks this protein on the cell surface and induces a type of cell death termed oncosis. Oncosis is distinct from apoptosis and is characterized by a loss of cell membrane integrity without DNA fragmentation. This gene product is proposed to function as a cell surface receptor that mediates cell death. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],
