Tissue Specificity	Ubiquitous; highest levels in testes, heart and skeletal muscle.
Function	caution:The sequence shown here is derived from an Ensembl automatic analysis pipeline and should be considered as preliminary data.,function:Probable substrate-specific adapter of an E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase complex which mediates the ubiquitination and subsequent proteasomal degradation of target proteins.,pathway:Protein modification; protein ubiquitination.,similarity:Contains 1 BTB (POZ) domain.,subcellular location:Cytoplasmic bodies.,subunit:Interacts with topoisomerase 1 and with TRIM5 isoform Delta. Interacts with CUL3.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous; higher levels in heart and skeletal muscle.,
Background	The C-terminus of the protein encoded by this gene binds topoisomerase I. The N-terminus contains a proline-rich region and a BTB/POZ domain (broad-complex, Tramtrack and bric a brac/Pox virus and Zinc finger), both of which are typically involved in protein-protein interactions. Subcellularly, the protein localizes to cytoplasmic bodies. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],



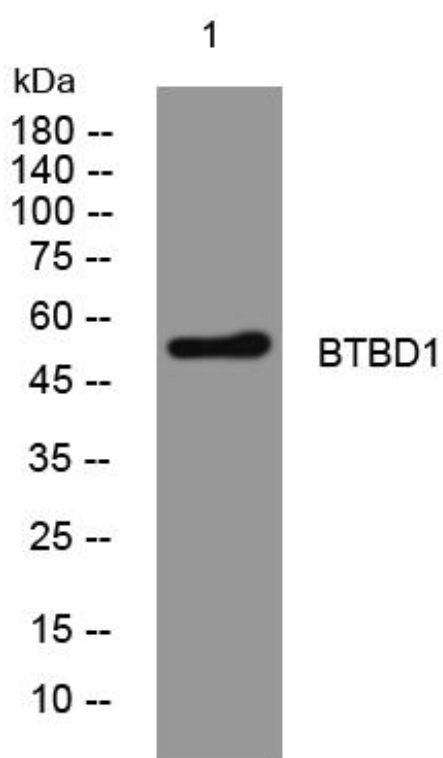
