

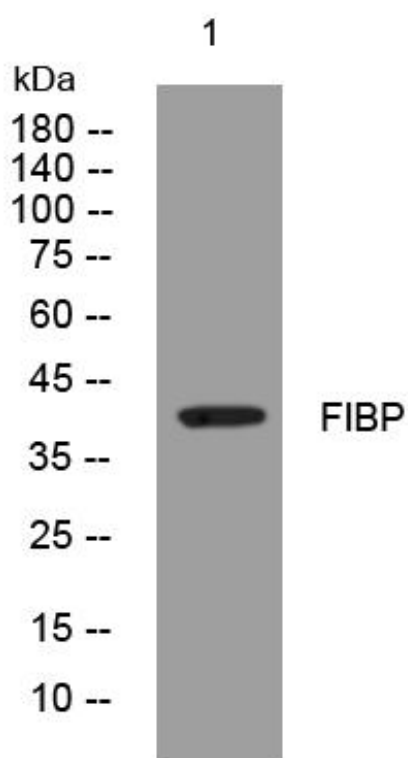

Cell Pathway	Nucleus. Endomembrane system; Peripheral membrane protein. Also associated with cytoplasmic membranes, particularly of mitochondria.
Tissue Specificity	Highly expressed in heart, skeletal muscle and pancreas. Expressed at lower levels in brain. Also found in placenta, liver and kidney.
Function	function:May be involved in mitogenic function of FGF1.,subcellular location:Also associated with cytoplasmic membranes, particularly of mitochondria.,subunit:Binds to internalized FGF1.,tissue specificity:Highly expressed in heart, skeletal muscle and pancreas. Expressed at lower levels in brain. Also found in placenta, liver and kidney.,
Background	Acidic fibroblast growth factor is mitogenic for a variety of different cell types and acts by stimulating mitogenesis or inducing morphological changes and differentiation. The FIBP protein is an intracellular protein that binds selectively to acidic fibroblast growth factor (aFGF). It is postulated that FIBP may be involved in the mitogenic action of aFGF. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],
