Cdc42 seems to be the preferred substrate.,similarity:Contains 1 CRAL-TRIO domain.,similarity:Contains 1 Rho-GAP domain.,subunit:Found in a complex with XPO7, EIF4A1, ARHGAP1, VPS26A, VPS29, VPS35 and SFN. Interacts with BNIPL.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous.,
Background	This gene encodes a member of a large family of proteins that activate Rho-type guanosine triphosphate (GTP) metabolizing enzymes. The encoded protein contains a SRC homology 3 domain and interacts with Bcl-2-associated protein family members. [provided by RefSeq, Aug 2012],

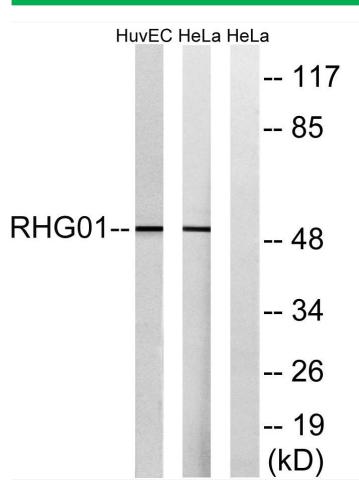
