Tissue Specificity	Expressed in liver, skeletal muscle, prostate, uterus, rectum, stomach, and bladder and to a lower extent in brain, kidney, pancreas, and bone marrow. Expressed in mononuclear leukocytes and megakaryocytes.
Function	similarity:Belongs to the small GTPase superfamily. Ras family.,tissue specificity:Expressed in mononuclear leukocytes and megakaryocytes. Not detected in platelets.,
Background	The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the Ras-related protein subfamily of the Ras GTPase superfamily. Members of this family are small GTPases that act as molecular switches to regulate cellular proliferation, differentiation, and apoptosis. This protein has been reported to activate in vitro transcriptional activity of the serum response element. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. 
