Enriched in small synaptic vesicles and adrenal microsomes, not present in chromaffin granules. Associated with both insulin granules and synaptic-like microvesicles in insulin-secreting cells of the pancreas. .
Tissue Specificity	Brain,
Function	function:Plays a role in the control of regulated secretion in neural and endocrine cells, enhancing selectively low-frequency neurotransmission. Positively regulates vesicle fusion by maintaining the readily releasable pool of secretory vesicles.,PTM:N-glycosylated.,similarity:Belongs to the major facilitator superfamily.,subcellular location:Enriched in small synaptic vesicles and adrenal microsomes, not present in chromaffin granules. Associated with both insulin granules and synaptic-like microvesicles in insulin-secreting cells of the pancreas.,subunit:Interacts with SYT1 in a calcium-dependent manner.,

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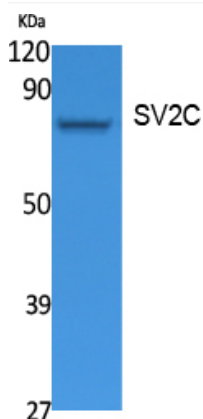

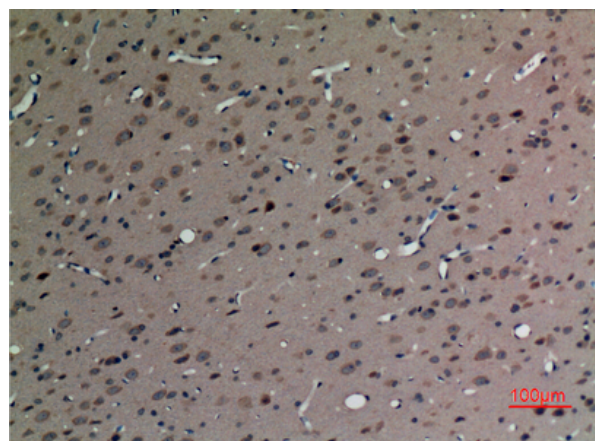
