Cell Pathway	Lysosome . Melanosome . Secreted, extracellular space . Apical cell membrane ; Peripheral membrane protein ; Extracellular side . Identified by mass spectrometry in melanosome fractions from stage I to stage IV (PubMed:17081065). Localizes to the lumen of thyroid follicles and to the apical membrane of thyroid epithelial cells (By similarity). .
Tissue Specificity	Expressed in the stratum spinosum of the epidermis. Weak expression is detected in the stratum granulosum.
Function	proteolysis, response to wounding, regulation of cell death, regulation of apoptosis, regulation of programmed cell death,
Background	catalytic activity:Hydrolysis of proteins with broad specificity for peptide bonds. Preferentially cleaves -Arg-Arg- -Xaa bonds in small molecule substrates (thus differing from cathepsin L). In addition to being an endopeptidase, shows

peptidyl-dipeptidase activity, liberating C-terminal dipeptides.,function:Thiol protease which is believed to participate in intracellular degradation and turnover of proteins. Has also been implicated in tumor invasion and metastasis., similarity:Belongs to the peptidase C1 family.,subcellular location:Identified by mass spectrometry in melanosome fractions from stage I to stage IV., subunit:Dimer of a heavy chain and a light chain cross-linked by a disulfide bond.,
