Function	function: Binds to the receptor tyrosine kinases EPHB4 and EPHA3. May play a role in constraining the orientation of longitudinally projecting axons., PTM: Inducible phosphorylation of tyrosine residues in the cytoplasmic domain., similarity: Belongs to the ephrin family., subunit: Interacts with PDZRN3 (By similarity). Binds to the receptor tyrosine kinases EPHB4 and EPHA3. Binds to Nipah virus G protein., tissue specificity: Lung and kidney.,
Background	This gene encodes a member of the ephrin (EPH) family. The ephrins and EPH-related receptors comprise the largest subfamily of receptor protein-tyrosine kinases and have been implicated in mediating developmental events,



especially in the nervous system and in erythropoiesis. Based on their structures and sequence relationships, ephrins are divided into the ephrin-A (EFNA) class, which are anchored to the membrane by a glycosylphosphatidylinositol linkage, and the ephrin-B (EFNB) class, which are transmembrane proteins. This gene encodes an EFNB class ephrin which binds to the EPHB4 and EPHA3 receptors. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],

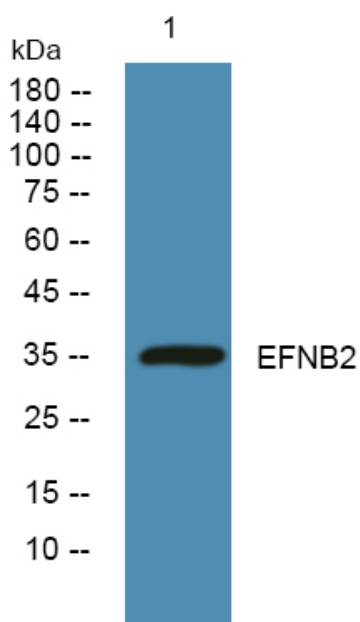
