Specific substrate for UBE1L2, not charged with ubiquitin by UBE1. May be involved in apoptosis regulation.,pathway:Protein modification; protein ubiquitination.,similarity:Belongs to the ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme family.,tissue specificity:Widely expressed. Highly in placenta, pancreas, spleen and testis.,
Background	This gene encodes an enzyme which ubiquitinates proteins which participate in signaling pathways and apoptosis. [provided by RefSeq, Feb 2012],

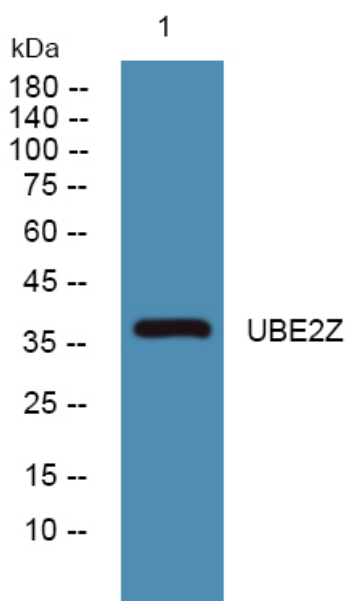
