Function	function:Integrin alpha-V/beta-8 is a receptor for fibronectin.,similarity:Belongs to the integrin beta chain family.,similarity:Contains 1 VWFA domain., subunit:Heterodimer of an alpha and a beta subunit. Beta-8 associates with alpha-V.,tissue specificity:Placenta, kidney, brain, ovary, uterus and in several transformed cells. Transiently expressed in 293 human embryonic kidney cells.,
Background	This gene is a member of the integrin beta chain family and encodes a single-pass type I membrane protein with a VWFA domain and four cysteine-rich repeats. This protein noncovalently binds to an alpha subunit to form a heterodimeric integrin complex. In general, integrin complexes mediate cell-cell and cell-extracellular matrix interactions and this complex plays a role in human airway epithelial proliferation. Alternatively spliced variants which encode



different protein isoforms have been described; however, not all variants have been fully characterized. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],
