This interaction is abolished only when these two domains are deleted., function:Act as a feedback negative regulator of signaling by receptor tyrosine kinases, through a mechanism that involves enhancement of receptor ubiquitination and accelerated intracellular degradation.,induction:By EGF., similarity:Contains 17 LRR (leucine-rich) repeats.,similarity:Contains 3 Ig-like C2-type (immunoglobulin-like) domains.,subunit:Interacts with EGFR/ERBB1, ERBB2, ERBB3 and ERBB4.,tissue specificity:Widely expressed.,

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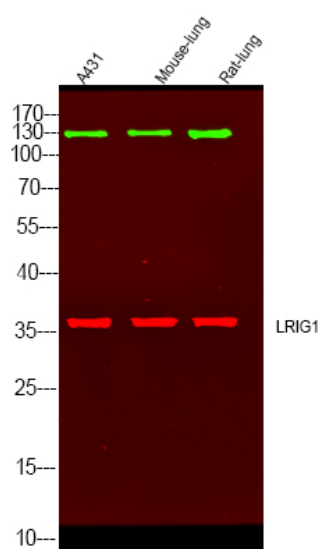
