Cell Pathway	Cell membrane ; Single-pass membrane protein . Golgi apparatus, trans-Golgi network membrane ; Single-pass membrane protein . Cytoplasmic vesicle, secretory vesicle . Located predominantly in the trans-Golgi network. Probably trafficks between the trans-Golgi network and the cell membrane via the secretory pathway.

Background	Targeting of numerous transmembrane proteins to the cell surface is thought to depend on their recognition by cargo receptors that interact with the adaptor machinery for anterograde traffic at the distal end of the Golgi complex. Consortin (CNST) is an integral membrane protein that acts as a binding partner of connexins, the building blocks of gap junctions, and acts as a trans-Golgi network (TGN) receptor involved in connexin targeting to the plasma membrane

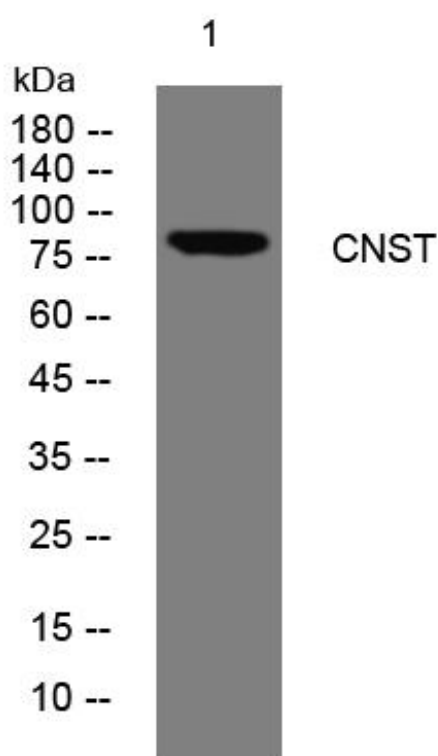
