Function	function:Proton-coupled intake of oligopeptides of 2 to 4 amino acids with a preference for dipeptides. May constitute a major route for the absorption of protein digestion end-products.,similarity:Belongs to the PTR2/POT transporter (TC 2.A.17) family.,
Background	This gene encodes an intestinal hydrogen peptide cotransporter that is a member of the solute carrier family 15. The encoded protein is localized to the brush border membrane of the intestinal epithelium and mediates the uptake of di- and tripeptides from the lumen into the enterocytes. This protein plays an important role in the uptake and digestion of dietary proteins. This protein also



facilitates the absorption of numerous peptidomimetic drugs. [provided by RefSeq, Apr 2010],
